One of the topics to be discussed is a widespread matter of concern. Sandy Dawson points out (LX, 2/87, p. 19) that wherever Logo is learned, mathematics is being learned, but many math teachers claim they do not have the time to teach both Logo and and the obligatory traditional curriculum. This

apparent conflict needs attention and resolution. This should be a valuable session.
